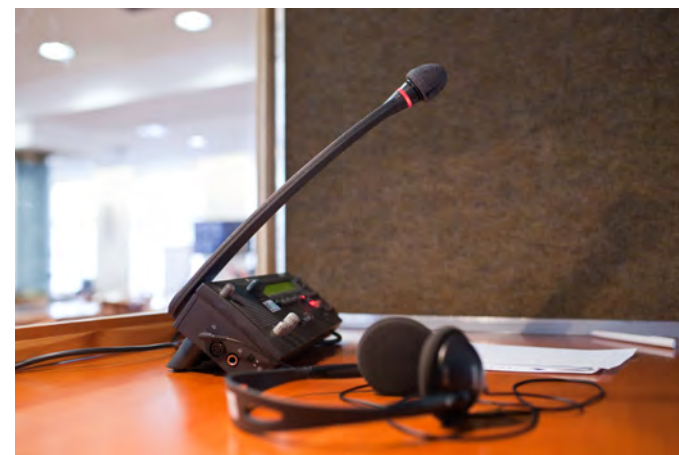

## Types of Conference Interpretation

**Simultaneous interpretation** is the process of interpreting from one language into another at the same time as the presenter is speaking. It is ideal for large conferences, especially with more than one language. The audience is provided with a small receiver headset to hear the interpretation. Simultaneous interpreters work in teams of two within a sound-proof booth. This method of interpretation allows the presenter to speak at a normal pace and should not slow down the event.



**Consecutive interpretation** is a method in which the presenter speaks for a short period of time and then the interpretation is given. It is best suited for one-on-one situations, small group meetings, short presentations and telephone interpreting. The extra time needed for the interpretation must be taken into consideration for planning purposes. This type of interpretation is useful only when a single language pair is being interpreted.

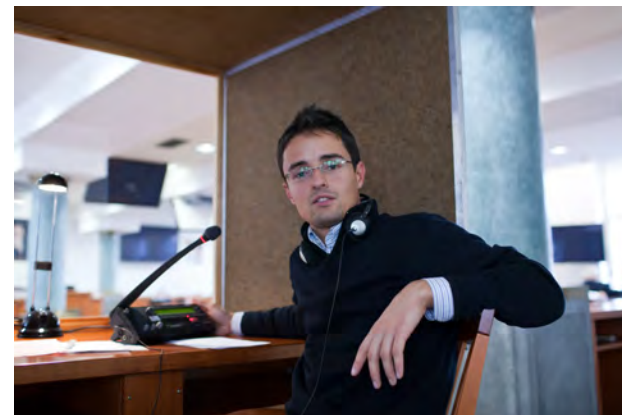
